This is a page of honor for our high school principal, who is retiring this year, Mr. Dale McNeely.

Mr. McNeely is a graduate of Lexington High School. He received a B.S. degree in physical education and history from Hanover College, where he played basketball and ran track. Mr. McNeely was an all-conference track performer and set a Hanover College Track record in the hurdles. He received his master's degree from Indiana University.


Mr. McNeely's first teaching and coaching job was in Paoli, Indiana. However, Uncle Sam drafted him the next year into the U.S. Army. After his discharge from the army during the next nine years he was head basketball coach and history teacher at New Marion (now South Ripley), Charlestown and Jeffersonville. He also coached other sports, such as, baseball, track, golf, cross country and tennis. The next ten years were spent at Morehead State University and Pikeville College in Kentucky. He was athletic director and head basketball coach at Morehead State Lab School, assistant professor in the university education department, then head basketball coach and dean of admissions at Pikeville College.

Returning to Indiana in 1975, Mr. McNeely served as assistant principal and athletic director at Paoli High School. In 1978, he was honored as athletic director of the year in District V. In 1983, he became principal of Cannelton High School, the position he holds today.

Mr. McNeely has served on many state level committees such as; the Indiana Secondary Schools Association, Publicity Committee and Smaller Schools Committee. Also, he served for three years as one of the ten principals in Indiana on the Executive Board of the Indiana High School Athletic Association which governs all of the state girls and boys sports.


Mr. McNeely will reside in Hanover with his wife, Martha, who has retired from Scott County School District 2 as their past assistant superintendent.






