# Week One: February 4th and 6th

The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle

Let's open up our Spring Discovery Time with a story about a very hungry caterpillar. In this story we learn how a caterpillar changes into a beautiful butterfly. There will also be an interactive play dough activity to go along with the story.

# Week Two: February 18th and 20th

The Very Lonely Firefly by Eric Carle

This story is all about light. This will be a special Discovery Time in which we use glow sticks to light our way in Neverland.

# Week Three: March 3rd and 5th

The Very Quiet Cricket by Eric Carle

For this Discovery Time, we will be talking about sound and having interactions with sound. There will be an activity to show you how to make your own noise makers for your child that you can then take home!

# Week Four: March 10th and 12th

Little Cloud by Eric Carle

Touch is one of the body's many important senses. This Discovery Time will allow your child to explore touch and relate what they're doing to what they're seeing.

#### Week Five: March 24th and 26th

Polar Bear, Polar Bear, What Do You Hear? By Bill Martin Sound helps us distinguish different noises and their meaning. Through this story we will learn different sounds and learn to make our own sound blocks.

# Week Six: March 31st and April 2nd

From Head to Toe by Eric Carle

This Discovery Time will really involve parent participation. We will explore the importance of mimicry and how it affects your child's development.

# Week Seven: April 7th and 9th

Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See? By Bill Martin During this Discovery Time we will be able to discover even more textures of everyday objects. This activity will help relate the objects we see to how they feel when touched.

# Week Eight: April 21st and 23rd

Panda Bear, Panda Bear, What Do You See? By Bill Martin We will discover how different objects, such as blocks, interact with one another. We will also be creating our own edible paint that may allow your child to explore new foods without forcing it at the dinner table.

# Week Nine: April 28th and 30th

Baby Bear, Baby Bear, What Do You See? By Bill Martin
We will make our very own texture book that you can take home and enjoy!
We will also practice our hand-eye coordination with a floating catch activity.

# Week Ten: May 5th and 7th

The Very Clumsy Click Beetle by Eric Carle
For this Discovery Time we will learn the sounds of the Click Beetle and
create our very own beetle.
